My roots in Del Mar are deep, reflecting decades of work protecting Del Mar as a special place to live. As a Del Mar resident since 1981, former City Attorney, committee and nonprofit volunteer, and lawyer, I have championed resident priorities: honoring our Community plan; lagoon restoration; a public vote on major downtown developments, and protection of our environment and open space. I authored the Beach Protection Initiative protecting our most valuable environmental asset.

I have a proven track record finding practical solutions while respecting divergent viewpoints. I have championed short-term rental regulations that protect residential neighborhoods; improving our DRB process; completing our Civic Center on time and on budget; implementing Streetscape; a balanced budget and strong financial condition; and fostering civility and respect in our decision-making.
